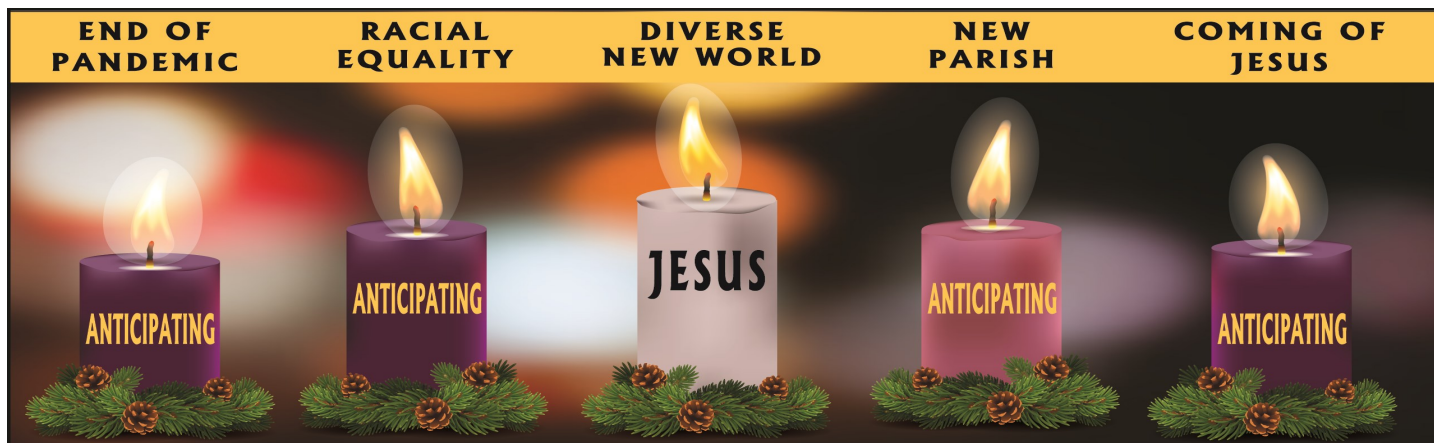


Trying to Wait in Hope
